

Roll Off Container Guidelines

Acceptable items include:

- Cardboard and / or wooden boxes
- General household solid waste
- Furniture
- Landscape / yard waste
 - Hedge clippings, palm fronds
 - Leaves, weeds, grass and small clippings
 - Tree limbs and branches
- Metal materials*
- Pipe
- Construction, remodeling or demolition solid waste**
- Manufactured items, such as washers, dryers, water heaters, and other appliances or equipment (NOT containing refrigerants)

Items NOT acceptable include:

- Tires
- Motor oil
- Lead acid batteries
- Paint
- Pesticide or other hazardous chemicals
- Medical waste / sharps



* Please separate large amounts of metal from household solid waste and/or yard waste.

** Note: if disposing of dirt, concrete, brick or masonry, *fill container less than halfway*. If container is too heavy to pick up, you will be required to unload and split into lighter, more manageable loads and will incur additional haul fees for multiple trips.

A \$110.00 dry run fee will be assessed if a *scheduled* pick up is refused for any reason or if container is too heavy to be moved safely.
