

## DID YOU KNOW

### **Bulk Trash Services:**

3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month.  
Residents must call 1-7 days  
in advance to schedule bulk  
trash pick-up at 520-466-3082.

### **Landfill Hours:**

Sun. & Mon. – **Closed**  
Tues. – Sat. **7:30 am – 2:30 pm**

- Any Eloy Resident may dump up to ½ ton (1,000 pounds) per day at the Landfill.
- Proof of Eloy residency will be required in the form of a current City of Eloy utility bill and a photo ID. The Landfill will not accept solid waste from Commercial Customers.

## **INOPERABLE VEHICLES**

Inoperable vehicles being restored or repaired (for longer than 10 days) must be stored safely within a lawfully enclosed building or structure or screened by a lawful fence so as not to be visible beyond the property boundaries/it may also be stored in back yards.

# Why Code Compliance?

The City of Eloy Code Compliance Division works in partnership with our citizens to promote and maintain a safe and attractive community.

*Neatly kept homes and front yards provide safe, attractive neighborhoods and help maintain property values throughout the City of Eloy. Our two Code Compliance Officers work in partnership with the community to promote health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Eloy through inspection, education and awareness. Our intent is to achieve voluntary compliance with our Property Maintenance Code. Property owners are the responsible party for property maintenance as well as the maintenance of sidewalks, alleys and other public improvements bordering their property.*



## ADOPT-A-STREET

There are still streets available to adopt if you are not currently a volunteer. This is a great opportunity for families and groups to participate and keep our community clean. ## GRAFFITI

It is the responsibility of the property owner to remove graffiti from buildings, structures, trailers, dumpsters and fences on their property. The City also has an anonymous Silent Witness Line to report crimes being committed: 520-464-3465

## FENCING

A fence, screen wall or retaining wall must be in good repair and structurally sound. Fencing must be self-supporting and constructed of durable wood, chain link, metal, masonry or other standard fencing material. • Fencing materials, colors and finishes must be consistent or compatible with materials, colors and finishes on the same fence or wall. • Electric fences are illegal. • It is also illegal to attach glass, nails, metal or materials that may cause injury.

## OUTSIDE STORAGE, JUNK AND GARBAGE

Junk, garbage or an accumulation of materials cannot be stored where it is visible from the front and side yard. If materials are stored, they must be stored in a building or structure, screened by a lawful fence so as not to be visible from property boundaries or removed to the back yard. Sidewalks, alleys and all public places bordering your property must also be kept clear and free of junk, impediments, and garbage. You may contact Public Works at (520) 466-3082 to schedule a [Bulk Trash Service](#) or you may dispose of materials at the Eloy Landfill.

## OPERATION ELOY CLEAN-UP

## YARD AND ALLEY MAINTENANCE

Poorly maintained landscaping, such as dead trees or shrubs and overgrown weeds, shrubs, trees and grass, is unattractive and can be a fire and safety hazard.

- Property must be kept free of weeds and grass more than 12 inches tall. Dead vegetation must be removed.
- Tree branches and shrubs must be trimmed.

## PARKING

It is unlawful to park or store any motor vehicle within the front or side yard of a single family residence unless it is parked or stored on an improved, dustproof parking surface.

## EXTERIOR HOUSING MAINTENANCE

Homes and other structures need to be maintained in a structurally sound condition and need to be impervious to moisture and weather.
